Gift Service and All Age Worship 8th December

We look forward to welcoming as many of you as possible to this service when we bring our gifts for those less fortunate than ourselves with love and prayers at this most special time of year. May we ask that you consider a financial donation, which you can make either by cash or by using the card reader available. This helps us to purchase Gift Vouchers which are distributed to Centre 56, Women's Refuge Centres, Whitechapel Centre and the YMCA centre helping the homeless into accommodation. These vouchers help families in particular to buy food at an even more difficult time of year when money is more stretched than ever as they struggle to provide.

Gifts of toiletries, e.g. small sets of men's toiletries. Sets of women's toiletries, warm hats, gloves and scarves, both men and women's. Selection boxes, boxes of Christmas biscuits and chocolates. Centre 56 at the moment has 86 children on roll. 45 families living with abuse, children with acute educational needs, financial hardship and other complex problems. They are open 50 weeks of the year. Christmas time is especially hard time for family units and for those struggling as single parents. Although toys are something we all love to give to children the staff find it more than helpful if we can donate financially through vouchers in particular as they can then buy the specific toys they know will suit each child they are working with.

The same applies to the Refuge centre as the numbers and ages/sexes of children change and emergency referrals mean that staff will not know what they need until the time.

The gifts of toiletries and warm hats etc will go to the homeless units The Whitechapel and YMCA centres work with.
